





- \$5,270 was presented in various scholarships and awards to several students.
- \$1,475 was used to coordinate and provide awards for three seasonal religious "Poster Contests." This supports the students enrolled in our Parish's Faith Formation program. In addition, we donated financial support to our local Catholic Grade School and Catholic High School.
- \$4,050 was used for financial assistance to local individuals in need and to supply coats for local Children.
- \$11,400 To foster community activity with the Parish Communion Breakfast, Block Party, St Damien Feast Day, Spaghetti Dinners and the Ocean City Knights Centennial celebration.

When you contribute to any of our Knights' fundraisers, 100% of the net proceeds go directly to our local Charitable Parish related functions or Charitable organizations!

We extend a special "Thank You" to our Pastor, Father Tom Newton and our KOC Chaplain, Father Vigilius Amanze for their support. We also want to acknowledge the Knights Women's Auxiliary and the many local businesses that assisted with our activities throughout the year:


