

With no designated overnight shelter in the county, people without stable housing are especially vulnerable when temperatures drop or storms hit, and they have limited options for warmth and safety. The Branches Outreach Center in Rio Grande provides essential support to those experiencing housing instability and hardship. This grassroots nonprofit offers warm meals, personal care items, clothing, showers, case management, food pantry services and a welcoming place to rest during the day. During Code Blue conditions — when temperatures fall to 32°F or below — The Branches extends its hours so guests can stay warm and access services while transportation is arranged to overnight warming centers.

Stewardship Service

"It is written: 'The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve.'" (MATTHEW 4:10)

Tempted between the riches and power of this world and service to God, Jesus chose service to His Father. If we wish to truly follow Jesus, we, too, must decide to turn away from worldly power and riches and put God at the center of our lives. Lent is our time to prune ourselves of earthly things and develop and nurture heavenly things. Lent is time to repent living **Stewardship** and letting go of the other "gods" we have put before God.

Handling Medical Emergencies In Church

February is Heart Month. Nurse/Helping Hands Ministry would like to review the handling of emergencies that may occur during Mass.

If needed, all three churches and the parish center have AED (Defibrillator devices for cardiac emergencies) and First Aid Kits. They are located in the Welcoming Spaces as you come into the churches and the center Hallway of the Parish Center. (The Nurse Ministry urges everyone to locate these devices. You may need to assist at some time in procuring the AED device or First Aid Kit)

If a parishioner should need medical help, please stand and announce in a clear voice: *"We need medical help here."*

Remain at the side of the ill parishioner until medical personnel arrive.

Designate someone to call "911." When calling in emergency: remain calm and state your location clearly, try to use a cell phone and stay close to the ill parishioner so questions may be answered and up to date information can be relayed to the dispatcher. Do not hang up. Stay on the line till Emergency personnel arrive.


If Health Care Providers are present in the congregation, they should identify themselves and go to assist the parishioner. Clear the lane and let the dispatcher know which entrance to the church would be the best entrance for the Emergency Personnel to enter. Have someone go outside and direct them when they do arrive.

Ushers will assist with crowd control and direct parishioners in close proximity to move from the pew to not block Health Care Providers.

If CPR is indicated, the AED device should be obtained from the Welcoming Space. Note: There is an alarm and strobe light that will go off when the AED device is removed from the cabinet. There is a key inside the box. Place the key in the lock on the left side of the cabinet to turn off the alarm after the emergency is over. Please place the key back in the cabinet.
