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The Parish of Saint Damien is Posting for the Position of a Permanent Part-Time Business Manager/Bookkeeper

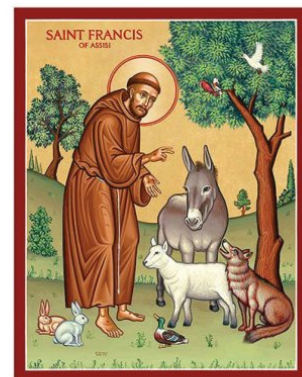

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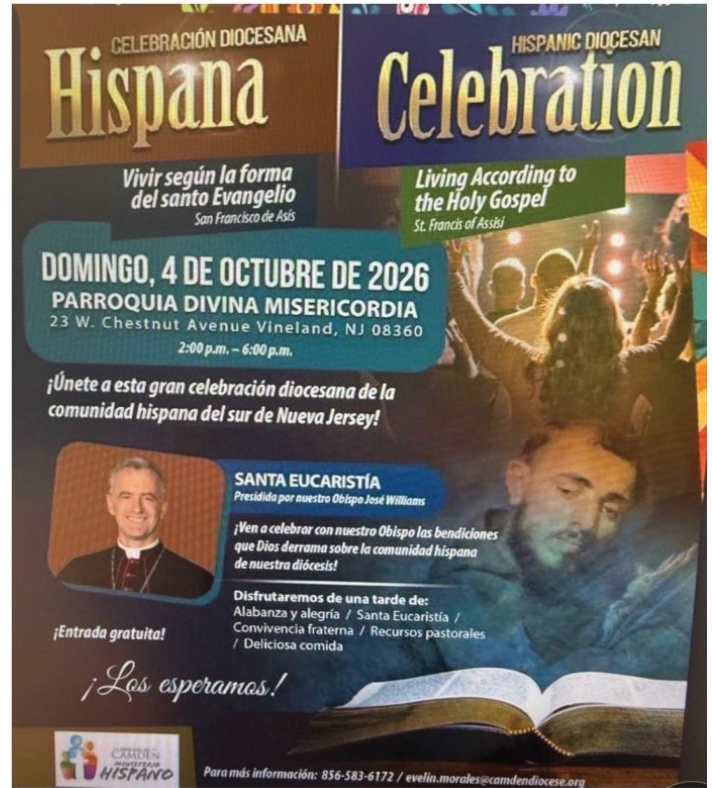

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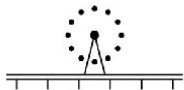
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
